

52.The following Federal Acquisition Regulation ("FAR") clauses are incorporated by reference to the extent indicated below. The effective version of each clause shall be the version that applies to BLUEHALO under its prime contract or higher-tier subcontract. In all cases, clauses shall be interpreted to apply to Seller as necessary to reflect the position of Seller as a subcontractor to BLUEHALO, to ensure Seller's obligations to BLUEHALO, and to enable BLUEHALO to meet obligations to its customer. For purposes of this introductory paragraph and the headings below, the term Subcontract shall include any agreement between BLUEHALO and Seller, to include any agreement between BLUEHALO and Seller, to include Subcontracts, Task Orders, Purchase Orders, Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) Agreements and Basic Ordering Agreements. Without limiting the forgoing: (1) unless the context of the clause or applicable law requires otherwise, the term "Contractor" shall mean "Seller" the term "Contract" shall mean the Subcontract as the term is defined above the term "Subcontractor" shall mean Seller's subcontractor, and the terms "Government", "Contracting Officer" and equivalent phrases shall mean BLUEHALO and BLUEHALO's Contractual Representative, respectively; (2) the words "Government" and "Contracting Officer" do not change when a right, act, authorization or obligation can be granted or performed only by the Government; and (3) where a clause specifies the number of days in which Seller must act, that number shall be reduced by half.
